Competition

Build It

Teams will meet at appointed venues where they will be given a selection of materials and asked to build a chosen item in an allotted time frame.

Eligibility

All participants must be Club members and teams must consist of 5 fully paid members aged 11-30 years.

Closing Date

The closing date for entries will be published by YFCU HQ.

Location

Teams will meet at allocated venues, where they will be given a selection of materials and asked to build a chosen item in 90 minutes. County heats will take place in allocated venues in five areas. Finals will rotate round the counties.

Additional Information

- Once the allocated time is complete, teams' efforts will be marked on strength, craftsmanship, ability to fit the purpose and imaginative use of all materials.
- The winning team from each County will go through to the Build It Final which will be held later (rotation round each county).
- Teams must remove their finished product and all materials from the competition heats and final.
- Members will be restricted in their efforts as they will only be permitted to use handheld tools and the only power tools allowed to be use are cordless drill and screwdriver.

- Teams are not permitted to begin until asked to do so by the Judge / Coordinator.
- Teams are not permitted to bring any additional material than what is provided.
- Health & Safety issues must be adhered to at all times and failure to comply with rules may lead to disqualification.

The Executive Committee of the YFCU reserves the right to cancel or amend any of the foregoing rules as it may consider necessary.
